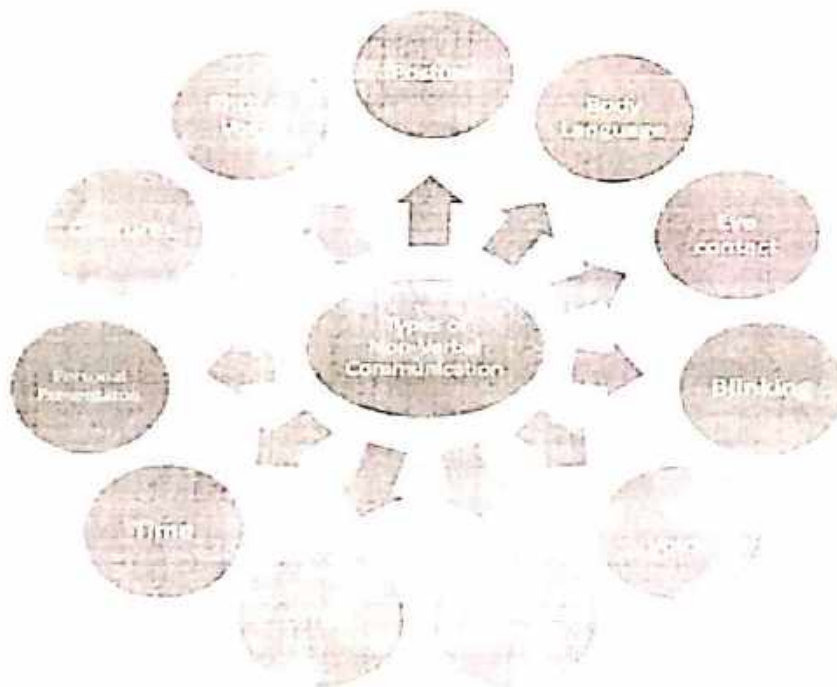
What is Communication?

Non-verbal communication includes facial expressions, the tone and pitch of the voice, gestures displayed through body language (kinesics) and the physical distance between the communicators (proxemics).

Nonverbal communication refers to the expression of signals or messages via gestures, facial expressions, and body language. Almost 75% of all communication is non-verbal. Eye contact, the

speed of voice, posture, and stance all contribute to the message we send and receive when communicating.

Hence, nonverbal communication is just as important as verbal communication when it comes to workplace relationships. Both managers and employees should pay attention to the way in which they communicate with their bodies, as it can greatly affect the message conveyed.

Nonverbal communication can be:

- **Repetition:** It repeats and often strengthens the message you're trying to convey.
- **Contradiction:** It can contradict the message you're trying to convey. For example, nodding to your listener that you may not be telling the truth.
- **Substitution:** It can substitute for a verbal message. For example, your facial expression often conveys a far more vivid message than words ever can.
- **Complementing:** It may add to or complement your verbal message. As a boss, if you pat an employee on the back in addition to giving praise, it can increase the impact of your message.
- **Accenting:** It may accent or underline a verbal message. Pounding the table, for example, can underline the importance of your message.

Nonverbal communication skills are essential and can make it easier to convey your point and to read what others are trying to tell you. Some people seem to come by these skills quite naturally, but anyone can improve their nonverbal skills with practice.
